## IN MEMORY OF NADINE JOUBERT 3 MARCH 1962 – 9 MAY 2024



Resident Nadine Joubert (62) sadly passed away suddenly on 9 May and a memorial service was held at the Home on 17 May.

Nadine will be remembered for her kindness, willingness to assist where needed and compassion towards her fellow residents. She always looked forward to her mother's visits and they would spend hours catching up over a cup of tea. The passing of her mother in February really took a toll on her, and unfortunately also impacted negatively on her already vulnerable health.

When she returned home after being hospitalised in March, she was determined to get her health back on track and decided to stop smoking, to improve her oxygen levels and consequently be less dependent on an oxygen machine.

During the weeks that followed, her health improved remarkably, and she became much more involved in Cheshire activities and was also able to continue with her responsibilities as a member of the Residents' Committee. We were all amazed by her newfound zest for life.

Nadine will be sorely missed by her family, friends and Cheshire family, but the memories of her will live on in the hearts and minds of her loved ones. RIP dear Nadine!
